Regional Youth Council

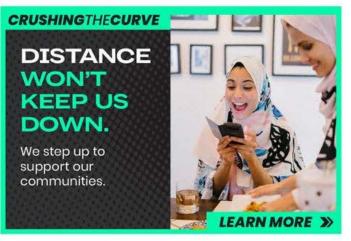
- Two youth per jurisdiction
