PROJECT UPDATES

April 2021 Activities

- On April 7th, the County hosted its first Social Equity workshop for Steering Committee Members and Planning Partners to present information and gather feedback on recommendations for addressing equity in the MJLHMP.
- Since March 15th, when Survey #1 was released seeking input from community members, 1,196 responses have been submitted in 4 languages.
- The third Steering Committee meeting was held on April 26th.
- The County's Internal LHMP Team continued to develop Phase 2 of the update to the County's Annex Plan.

May 2021 Activities

- Outreach efforts continue with community-based organizations and planning partners, including MJLHMP presentations and discussion opportunities.
- Beginning on May 20 through June, the MJLHMP Team, in coordination with County Communications, will issue Survey #2 to community members seeking input on Mitigation Actions. Focus groups will also be utilized.
- The fourth Steering Committee meeting will occur on May 24th.
- The County's Internal LHMP Team will complete Phase 2 and begin development of Phase 3 of the update to the County's Annex Plan.
